With affordable hire rooms and spaces, as well as a host of opportunities for organisations to build peace partnerships and share space, the Peace Campus focuses on ethical Development and Stakeholder Engagement. This is underpinned by its Sustainability Strategy designed to increase awareness of the Peace Campus by reaching the widest audiences possible in order to foster long-term community engagement via multiple channels and platforms.

Objectives:

- Develop an integrated, innovative approach to peacebuilding, peace stakeholder partnerships and programmes
- Apply a circular economy to sustain Peace Campus services and amenities for all communities and stakeholders in Peace alike.
- Utilise Communications and Engagement Strategies to connect with local, national, international, digital audiences and Stakeholders. By doing this, we can involve and join with diverse communities and visitors, as we leverage new opportunities and maximise existing ones.

- Later in 2025 launch of a new Social Enterprise Partnership café to improve visitor experiences of hospitality, encourage greater footfall; support local businesses and suppliers, Currently, visitors can enjoy the self-service barista bar area in the café
- A new recording studio will be created in Year 2 to provide additional hire space for communities to ensure digital content development, recordings, podcasts and more. This will assist with Peacebuilding programmes and initiatives including creating and sharing stories, digital peace bank activities, music-making and cultural activities are produced – all requiring access to professional AV recording facilities.
- Promote our unique, affordable hire rooms and spaces to all communities and identified Stakeholders to ensure they can utilise the Peace Campus and its services to their fullest. Ensure hospitality and AV amenities are in place for all with no local business displacement.
- Management of our tenancy relationships with like-minded organisations whose support and investment with Youth and Community Services on site can sustain our growth and development.
- Implement our **Fiscal Policy Strategy** to ensure long term sustainability, growth and development of the Peace Campus.
